



## Questions To Ask Your EHR Vendor About Public Health Reporting For Stage 2 Meaningful Use

1. Has my EHR system been certified under the 2014 ONC Certification Program (CEHRT) for all public health reporting measures?
  - a. If so, what version was certified and what is the ambulatory CHPL certification number?
  - b. What will it cost me to migrate to this version? When would it be available?
  - c. Please be specific about the cost structure for the certified version including any implementation, ongoing maintenance, subscription or transactional fees per public health measure/interface.
  - d. If not certified, when do you expect to be 2014 ONC certified?
2. Do you have any clients currently electronically submitting production public health data to the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) on an ongoing basis today?
  - a. If yes, for which measures?
  - b. How is this occurring? Through a direct connection to ODH or are you sending public health data on behalf of clients through CliniSync ([www.clinisync.org](http://www.clinisync.org)) to ODH?
  - c. If CliniSync, how many CliniSync clients are you supporting for reporting public health data today?
  - d. If through a direct connection to ODH, do I need to sign a separate contract or agreement for this service?
3. Can you support a separate MU2-compliant interface for each measure that meets Ohio's specific requirements?
4. Can you send the interface data via TCP/IP VPN to CliniSync? (The connection parameters will be provided by CliniSync.)
5. What changes in my EHR or workflow will be necessary to support public health reporting?
6. Describe how your software will support the necessary requirements to capture, codify and transport the data to meet MU2 requirements.
7. Are you willing to work with me to provide the necessary technical information to enroll and register my intent through the Ohio Department of Health Public Health Enrollment site?
